2. Approval of the Agenda

President Steve Gorden asked if there were any additions to the agenda. <u>Comm. Hobart moved to approve the</u> agenda as presented. The motion was **seconded** by Comm. Blodgett, and the motion **passed** with no objections.

- 3. Consent Agenda: Additions, Changes or Deletions?
 - a. Approval of the Minutes

President Steve Gorden requested a motion to move the consent agenda. <u>Comm. Fournier moved to approve</u> <u>the consent agenda which included the minutes, the financial report and the Treasurer's report. Comm. Hobart seconded the motion, and it was passed with no further comments.</u>

- 4. Reports & Presentations:
 - a. Legislative Policy Report Brian Hobart, Chair
 - i. Legislative Update, James Cohen, Verrill Dana

MCCA lobbyist James Cohen reported on the progress of preparations for the forum with the gubernatorial candidates planned for the MCCA/MSA meeting on September 14th. Questions were being developed and would not be announced ahead of time. Steve said attendees should be prepared with more questions in case time allowed for Q&A with the group. Jim said he had been asked to serve as moderator for the forum and accepted the role.

Mr. Cohen reported on the meeting with the Maine State Police (MSP), MCCA and the Sheriffs. More light was shed on the history of rural patrol. It was acknowledged that there were fewer hours assigned to rural patrol now that more specialty units are being maintained. There have been changes in the workplace, number of hours worked, and programs to manage. It was not disputed that MSP is providing less coverage. Jim pointed out it's important to remember where each group is coming from. MSP positions are not elected unlike the Sheriffs and County Commissioners who need to consider more carefully what their constituents want. Also, Commissioners need to consider the budget more than the other two groups.

Comm. Hobart said it was a learning experience. Commissioners sign the checks but are not necessarily experts on law enforcement. As an organization, we need to support MSA as much as we can. Comm. Gorden agreed. He said he had notes from the meeting which highlighted that MSP had no positions added to rural patrol since the 1970's. They pointed out the legislature is part of the puzzle. Asked if they could have a meeting with all the groups involved. They were hesitant, but we've got to discuss it openly if we're going to have a chance to solve the problem. We also need clarity about language. The Legislature would likely vote to have sheriffs provide the service but not if it effects the finances. Comm. Hobart pointed out Chiefs are not elected and need to be more careful about what they say. Comm. Fournier was impressed with the information presented at the meeting; and left with the impression they would be willing to meet

with any of the groups. It was very eye opening. Jim obtained the 2018 MSP capacity report which stated there were 78 less troopers in 2018. If we're going to get traction, we need to get together and join forces with MSP, MSA, and bring in MMA when we're ready. Admin. Scott Ferguson said he had a report showing MSP funding steadily increased over the years although they might not be using the money for rural patrol. He said he would share this report.

- 1. Dates by which proposed legislation needs to be submitted(?)

 The date is undetermined, but likely to be in the last two weeks of December.
- b. Administrative Report Lauren

Administrator Lauren Haven reported that MCCA's work on the audit was complete. The auditors at RHR Smith are waiting for their quality control department to review their work on the 2020-2021 audit before they send the reports to us.

- c. Treasurer's Comments Norm Fournier 2020/2021 Audit Report, RHR Smith and Company (if available)
- d. Officer Reports: President Reports:
 - i. September 14th: Training Day RSVP and Update

President Gorden explained the details for the scheduled conference day on September 14th which will be in person at the Senator Inn in Augusta. He mentioned Comm. Liberty from the Department of Corrections will be speaking in the afternoon about integrating jail requirements. This led to a brief discussion about the jail bill changing the way payments are disbursed from lump sum payments to quarterly payments. This change presents an issue for some jails because the money is needed up front to pay for operational expenses. Additionally, there are several steps that need to be completed for the funding to be released. For example, the money is tied to CRAS reporting. President Gorden said we should bring this topic up again later.

- 5. Affiliate Organizational Committee Reports recognize those in attendance or who submitted Information:

MARP - Probate Register Kathy Ayers reported there was a lack of attorneys in guardian cases. There are statutory deadlines that must be met. Part of the problem is the pay scale. The rate that needs to be paid is \$80, and even at that rate, there are not enough attorneys willing to do the work. Policies and procedures around *ex parte* emergency guardianships were likely to be part of the problem. For example, if someone is hospitalized there might be a need for an emergency guardianship. There need to be two full hearings in a very short amount of time which is an issue, especially for smaller counties that don't pay as much as the standard \$80 rate. Comm. Gorden asked if Ms. Ayers would gather the information into a report so we could work on developing a solution. Jim Cohen mentioned the \$80 is a moving target. That figure was not necessarily going to be enough and there needed to be a plan to increase the rate as the number changes to stay competitive.

MACCAM – Carrie Kipfer reported the association hadn't met since the last MCCA meeting.

Admin. Scott Ferguson said he received an update on County Jail funding distributions for FY23 from Mitchell Boynton, the Service Center Director of the Department of Admin and Financial Services at the Corrections Service Center. Community corrections paperwork was required to be submitted prior to the release of the county jail payments. Mr. Boynton was understaffed by two positions and was in the middle of crunching budget numbers. However, he said he would try to work on county jail payments by the end of the week.

Comm. Steve Gorden asked if there were other comments for the good of the organization. Hearing none, <u>President Gorden invited a motion to adjourn at approximately 10:55 a.m. Comm. Erkkinen made the motion</u> seconded by Comm. Hobart, and the motion to adjourn was approved.
