Hourly Pay Rate:

To allow for comparisons across all municipalities, if this position is paid an annual salary, calculate the hourly rate using the following formula:

Annual Salary divided by Total Hours Worked per Year (Calculated as Hours Worked per Week x 52).

For example: If your average hours worked per week are 35, and your annual salary is \$50,000, you would divide \$50,000 by 1820 (52x35), for an hourly rate of \$27.47.

If there are multiple employees in this position with differing pay scales, average the hourly rate paid.

Do not include any additional compensation when reporting hourly rate.
